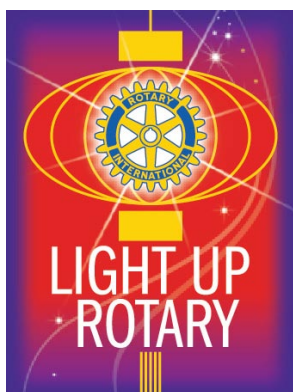
### Month of Vocational Service

“He Profits Most Who Serves Best”, is Rotary’s second motto. This is the principle for people who do their work [vocation] even before the establishment of Rotary.

However, irresponsibility, omitted duties and deceptive management spread. Owing to this, Paul Harris and his fellows established the Rotary Club in 1905 with the aim that at least Rotarians will abide to responsible management. Rotary Clubs extended and sincere, trustworthy and honorable Rotarians from both professional and business worlds promoted Rotary and inducted many more people to join Rotary.

Meanwhile, the concept of “Vocational Service” as a golden rule in Rotary was introduced temporarily. However, this made it very difficult to define what “Vocational Service” really meant. For example, “Vocational Service” can hardly be defined or observed by naked eyes when comparing with services like helping to save a child’s life, donating wheel-chairs to the disabled or sending scholars to study in a foreign country. In addition, vocational classification is on the increase as compared to the time when Rotary was first established. In Rotary, usually Club Service, Community Service and International Service are carried out on a group basis, whereas Vocational Service is performed on an individual basis. However, as observed, Vocational Service is not necessarily enforced only by an individual, and Vocational Internship for the Young Generations can be carried out either by an individual or by a group of Rotarians.
